#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**







Draw a tree on a piece of paper



Make tree branches and write the numbers 2 to 12



On another piece of paper draw and cut 12 mangos. These will be used to cover the numbers




Roll the die. Add the 2 numbers and cover the matching tree branch, e.g., if you roll 3 and 4, cover tree branch 7





Roll the die until all the tree branches are covered


Cardboard Box, Scissors, Different Objects

#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**






Cut a hole in the box, large enough for your arm to fit inside.



Ask someone else to put their hand inside the box and guess what it is. "Is it hard or soft? What shape is it?"



Place an object inside the box but don't tell anyone what you put inside. For example, you could put corn, an apple, a plant or a toothbrush/hairbrush, etc.




#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**



Choose different kids to be different roles in the shop. For example: shopper, cashier and security guard.



Arrange all the items on a table. You can put empty food bottles, soap, or clothes. Put price tags on each item.



Make sure you have made your pretend money with paper



Have everyone take their positions in the shop. The shoppers walk into the store and choose the items they wish to purchase and take them to the cashier to pay. Have conversations with each other. For example, shoppers can compare prices and ask the cashier if there are any new deliveries or special deals.




The cashier totals and packs all the items. The shopper pays for the items.






#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**





Create a paper bridge using only newspaper. You can roll, fold and layer the paper




Try to create a paper bridge that is strong enough for a toy car to cross over the bridge without it breaking.



Try your car on the newspaper bridge.
Call out "wasee wasee", and respond with "msee msee". The driver will then say "nataka kuvuka ng'ambo ile lakini daraja kaporomoka". You should then respond by telling the driver to say the magic word and a bridge will be built for them.

In magazines and newspapers, find pictures and words that are about you




Cut and glue them on your paper



Be creative, you can include things you like to eat and things you enjoy. For example, eating chocolate cake or playing soccer.

Banana, Knife, Lemon

#### **LEARNING AREA**

Science and Technology

#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**







Cut the banana and cut the lemon



Leave them for 10 minutes. Which banana do you think will turn brown?



Eat the bananas!



On one plate put a slice of banana. On the other plate put a slice of banana and squeeze lemon juice on it



The banana slice with lemon juice did not turn brown because the lemon juice coating prevents the oxygen from combining with the slice, preventing oxidation.



Plastic Water Bottle, Liquid Vegetable Oil, Water, Food Colour, Baking Soda

#### **LEARNING AREA**

#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**





Fill a glass bottle halfway with water



Add drops of food colour



Fill the rest of the glass with vegetable oil



Put a little baking soda. Observe the liquid fizz carrying the coloured water bubbles through the oil.



#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**




What information does a map have? It could have your school, your home, where you buy fruits and vegetables, your church/mosque, etc.





Draw the Map of the Neighbourhood. Include stores, your neighbour's house, your best friend's house, school and your place of prayer.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:**



1 Hour



Start by filling up 4 clear cups with water. Fill the water to almost the top of the cup











Place the cups in a line with an empty cup in between



Add 1 drop of red food colouring to two of the cups, 1 drop of blue food colouring to one of the cups and 1 drop of yellow to one of the cups.



The water and dye will start to move



Fold over 6 pieces of cloth and connect with the empty cups
