INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:






1. One child picks a card and does not show it to anyone else.




This child tries to get the others to guess what the word on the card is by acting out the word on the card and using their body movements. The child must try to do this without saying a word.



Let everyone take a turn to pick a card.





4 Small Buckets or Containers, 2 Cups, Water or Sand

Creative Arts and Movement


INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:



1 Hour



Have the 2 teams line up at a starting point and place a full bucket of water or sand at the front of each line



Set an empty bucket about 20ft away from each team



Give the child at the front the cup



Fill up the cup with water and run to the empty bucket and pour the water from the cup



Run back and give the cup to the next person in line. The first team to fill their bucket to the top wins


Choose the animal you want to make




Draw basic shapes -Rectangles, Triangles, Circles

Paper, Scissors, Green Crayon or Marker, Tape, Brown paint (optional), Paintbrush (optional)



INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:



1 Hour



Tree trunk: Roll the paper into a tube and tape



Paint the tree trunk brown and let dry (optional)

Tree Top: Cut some leaf shapes from paper for the tree



Colour the paper leaves green




Attach the paper leaves to make a tree



On each leaf of the tree, write a dare. Choose a dare and complete it.

Here are some examples of dares and you can create your own:

- Do your best lion roar
- Sing the ABCs/alphabet backwards
- Pretend to be a Giraffe or Elephant etc.
- Dance to a song
- Close your eyes and guess who is shaking your hand
- Jump on 1 leg





INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:





Cut out the letters



Give each child a letter



Ask one child to start telling a story based on their letter. Then have each child continue that story by adding to it using the letter that they are holding

Letter S: His stomach was making




















Ball, 10 Plastic Water Bottles, Water, Small Rocks or Sand

Creative Arts and Movement




1 Hour




Fill the plastic water bottles halfway with water, rocks or sand



Line up the plastic water bottles or 3D Paper Animals in rows



Stand 10 steps away and face the bottles



Roll the ball and knock down as many as possible


Draw your puppet on paper and make the face of a person or an animal

Attach your puppet to the stick



MATERIALS: Stick Puppets


LEARNING AREALanguage and Literacy

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:




1 Hour



Draw a picture on a piece of paper and cover as much of the paper as possible




Colour in the picture



Cut the paper into several puzzle pieces, like rectangles or triangles




Mix up the pieces in a bag



Rearrange the pieces to make your picture again

Plastic Bottle, 4 Bottle Tops, Wooden Sticks, String, Knife or Scissors

LEARNING AREA

Science and Technology

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO PLAY:



Clean the plastic bottle.




Cut two holes on each side of the bottle.




Put the sticks through the holes. Make a small hole in each bottle top and attach them to the sticks.



Cut the upper part of the bottle slightly after placing the wheels (making room for the chairs or carrying things)



Tie a string to the neck (top part) of the bottle. Pull the car using the string
