

...except for Jabali.




Today, Jabali didn't want to do anything.

The liquid covered his hands.




Suddenly, Jabali started growing,

and growing,




and growing,

And you may not be as tall as him.


One day you might grow taller -

He's going to show you an amazing game or activity that you can play with your friends or by yourself.




LET'S MAKE SOMETHING

Materials: Paper, Scissors, Colours, Glue or Tape




1

Fold a piece of paper in half




2
