

so they follow the crack into the ocean blue.**






**It zigs and zags along the bottom of the sea bed,

Just then, Opita came rushing from the sea.


“Jabali, Sauti, and Bibi, please come with me!” Opita begged.

I should have seen this coming.”**






“I’ll seal the crack and the kelp will stop dying,

He's going to show you an amazing game or activity that you can play with your friends or by yourself.



Materials: Skipping Rope, Cup




1 Get ready to skip rope with your friends



2 Choose a jumper. They have to hold a full cup of water and jump rope for 10 turns.




3 Change turns and replace the full cup of water until everyone has had a turn to be the jumper

The first person has to pass the cup to the person behind them raising their arms over their head, without turning around and trying not to spill the water



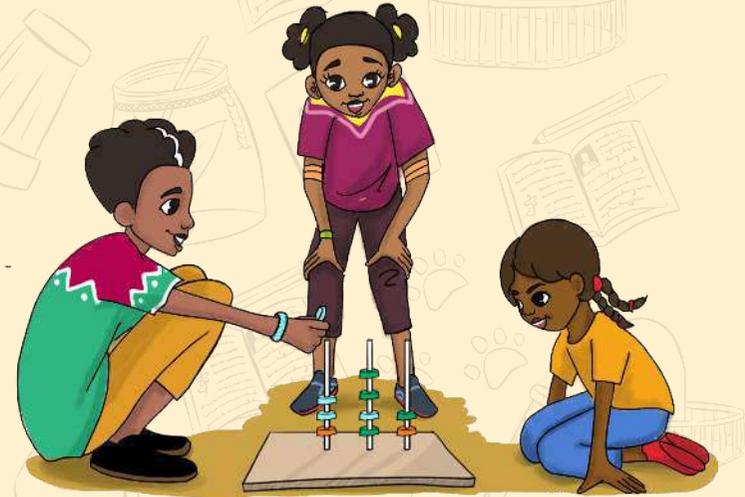
